



## **PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING WHEN TAKING ASSISTANCE FROM A FACILITATOR**

1. Never give cash/cheque/DD to a facilitator for investment amount. Pay facilitators convenience fee only.
2. Bharosa Club does not have any of its own products and is not authorized to keep investor money or deposits.
3. Never take advice from a facilitator unless they are an RIA/ARN holder. A facilitator who is not an RIA/ARN holder is only authorized to help you use Bharosa website or app.
4. Anyone can become a facilitator and Bharosa conducts no due diligence on facilitators so use one at your own risk. Facilitators have no relationship with Bharosa. They are not employees or agents and may facilitate many goods and services other than Bharosa. Ideally a facilitator will be someone from your community/area that you know, or a friend knows. Number of thumbs up can be a good indicator of the reliability of a facilitator
5. A scamster may take convenience fees from you and do nothing. Use common sense to avoid such situations.
6. Take a photo of the facilitator and check his/her mobile by giving a missed call in case you do not know the facilitator.

8. USE COMMON SENSE. You use facilitators for many things and you trust your instincts to prevent getting duped.
